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

The let er sequence, CMIT, has been registered with the United States Patent and Trademark Of ce since March 25, 2017 This trademark, the CMIT designat on, is protected under U S and internat onal law and any unauthorized uses are prohibited Violators are subject to prosecut on under applicable laws. In order to use the CMIT designat on, individuals or organizat ons must hav ran c that CMIT cert t designat is

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CMIT applicat ons may be filled out online, printed and mailed, or faxed along with required documentation and payment as noted on the application. All signatures must be submited by the applicant and statements in the application agreed to, as provided in the CMIT application. Along with meeting the eligibility requirements, CMIT candidates are required to agree to the CMIT Conditions and Conduct Agreement, as noted in the CMIT application.

Applicat ons may be rejected for several reasons including: incomplete applicat on, eligibility criteria not sat sf ed, or applicat on fee payments outstanding. A let er of explanat on will be emailed to the applicant specifying reasons for non-advancement if their applicat on is rejected. Applicants are encouraged to make sure to include all required documentat on with their applicat on to avoid denial and/or delay.

About the CMIT

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The CMIT Commit ee shall have the power to, but shall not be obligated to, invest gate all allegations of unprofessional and unethical conduct that may be harmful to colleagues, owners, dients, the public, or that otherwise may be contrary to the object ves of the CMIT Conditions and Conduct Agreement provided that such allegations are made in writing and are signed by the complainant. If during the course of its investigation on the Commities determines there may be additional violations of the code, the commities may invest gate and reach appropriate findings regarding the additional violations.

Mat ers involving fraudulent use of the designation will be invest gated and aggressively pursued by CMCI

Any individual found to have breached the CMIT Condit ons and Conduct Agreement is subject to revocat on of CMIT status Informat on on a cert f cate holder supporting a complaint of noncompliance may be submited from any source. A complaint in writing received by the CMCI staf will be referred to the CMIT Commitee for investigation.

Following receipt of an of cial not ce of noncompliance from CMCI, the CMIT will have a 30-day period in which correct ve act on or response to the sat sfact on of the CMIT Commit ee
